The prize is awarded to the artist who creates the most meaningful connection and impact, using original thought and creativity to achieve this. The show has gained a prestigious reputation and will be its eighth edition.

The prize

The winner of the Royal Arts Prize will be selected by a judging panel of 8 art relevant persons and will be announced at the end of the show.

The Prize is a two week long solo show in one of our art galleries (La Galleria Pall Mall or The Royal Opera Arcade Gallery) at a date to be agreed with the artist winner.



Artwork criteria & terms of participation

All media is accepted, including but not limited to; paintings, prints, illustrations, collages, digital art, photography, sculptures, Ceramics, Glass Work

Please submit 8 high-quality JPEG images (minimum 300 dpi) representative of your body of work and available for exhibit (including titles, techniques, medium and dimensions) via email to

If your artworks are 30cm x 30cm or less 6 pieces will be chosen to exhibit.
If your artworks are up to 70cm x 90cm 4 pieces will be chosen to exhibit.
If your artworks are over 90cm 2 pieces will be chosen to exhibit.

Participation fee to exhibiting artists £600 + VAT

The participation fee of £600+VAT includes:

- Exhibition space
- Professional curation and set up of the exhibition
- Vernissage – Preview Opening with drinks, canapés and serving staff (COVID-19 dependent)
- Dedicated sales staff
- Mailing list promotion (buyers, galleries, art lovers)
- Online marketing (social media, exhibition listing via gallery account)
- Promotional materials; catalogue, exhibition posters
- Inclusion in an online catalogue on the gallery website (for the duration of 6 months after the end of the exhibition)



Delivery of Artworks

Each artist is responsible for delivering and collecting their art work to the gallery ready for exhibiting (details will be provided upon acceptance). Cost of shipping will be paid by the artist.

La Galleria Pall Mall will take 10% commission of the sale price on all artwork sales. There will be an additional charge of 3% of the sale price for payments taken via credit card machine.

Conditions to propose artwork

Please submit **8 images** representative of your body of work and available for exhibit (including titles, techniques, medium and dimensions) via email to:

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If your works are preselected for the exhibition a **deposit of £100** will be required in order to save your place in our shortlisted exhibition, the rest of the participation fee will be paid 4 weeks prior to the exhibition.

Deposits will be non-refundable.
